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Bus Etiquette

1. QUIET TIME

We try and provide a quiet time between Midnight and 8:00 AM. We will limit using the audio and video equipment on the coach during this travel time. For your comfort dress in layers and bring a small blanket as we try to keep the bus at a constant temperature.



2. BATHROOM

Please limit bus bathroom use to emergencies due to its small tank, which is emptied at trip's end. Tour Directors schedule regular restroom stops for passenger comfort.



3. BE CONSIDERATE

Just use courtesy and common sense. Try to accommodate and compromise whenever you can. Be polite and respectful of fellow passengers. Please have a positive attitude and be prepared to have lots of fun! The Bus is a **NO SCENTS ZONE!**



4. RECLINING SEAT

Check behind you and excuse yourself before you recline your seat. Someone may be leaning forward, on their tablet, or have a drink in hand. Then please recline your seat slowly! A good rule we like to follow is if one reclines we all recline!



5. LUGGAGE

Overhead storage space above each seat is limited. Pack only what is comfortable to have on your lap or at your feet. Keep medications with you as we cannot dig for luggage after it is put in the compartment underneath the bus.



6. MIND YOUR FOOD

When traveling by bus, select drinks and food that are unlikely to spill if the bus has to make any sudden movements. Avoid eating or drinking anything that has a strong smell or odor. Smells can linger long after you're done eating.



7. GARBAGE

Keep your personal space neat and tidy. Take your garbage off the bus with you at each stop.



8. COMPLETE STOP

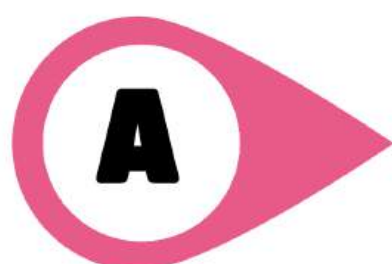
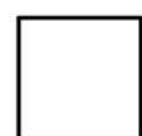
For your safety, please do not stand or move around the bus when the bus is in motion. Please stay safe and remain seated.

3:00 - 9:30am: Meet the bus at your designated departure time and location.

9:30 - 10:00am: Border crossing - We will be getting off the coach for passenger processing. Welcome to the USA - All itinerary times from this point are in US time. Please keep all your receipts for any items purchased in the US coming home with you. Your personal exemption is \$800 Canadian including alcohol and tobacco purchases. For alcohol you are allowed 1.5 L of wine or 1.14 L of liquor or 24 x 355 ml cans or bottles of beer or ale. You must be 19+ to claim any alcohol.



10:30 - 12:00pm: Breakfast at Dysart's Restaurant & Truck Stop. Breaks and snacks for the rest of the route today will be limited to 15-30 minute stops for grab and go.



1:00pm: Break, beer/cooler and snack stop will be limited to 15-30 minutes for grab and go.
