Bus Etiquette

1. QUIET TIME

We try to provide a quiet time between Midnight and 8:00 AM. We will limit the use of audio and video equipment on the coach during this travel time. For your comfort, dress in layers and bring a small blanket as we try to keep the bus at a constant temperature.



2. BATHROOM

Please limit bus bathroom use to emergencies due to its small tank, which is emptied at the trip's end. Tour Directors schedule regular restroom stops for passenger comfort.



3. BE CONSIDERATE

Just use courtesy and common sense. Try to accommodate and compromise whenever you can. Remember, our bus is a Scent-Free zone for everyone's comfort. Please be polite and respectful, have a positive attitude, and be prepared to have lots of fun!



4. RECLINING SEAT

Check behind you and excuse yourself before you recline your seat. Someone may be leaning forward, on their tablet, or have a drink in hand. Please recline your seat slowly! A good rule is that if one person reclines, everyone should recline.



5. LUGGAGE

Overhead storage space is limited. Pack only what you can comfortably keep on your lap or at your feet. Keep medications with you; we cannot dig for luggage once it has been packed under the bus. We allow one large suitcase and one small carry-on per person.



6. MIND YOUR FOOD

When traveling by bus, select drinks and food that are unlikely to spill if the bus has to make any sudden movements. Avoid eating or drinking anything that has a strong smell or odor. Smells can linger long after you're done eating.



7. GARBAGE

Keep your personal space neat and tidy. Take your garbage off the bus with you at each stop.



8. COMPLETE STOP

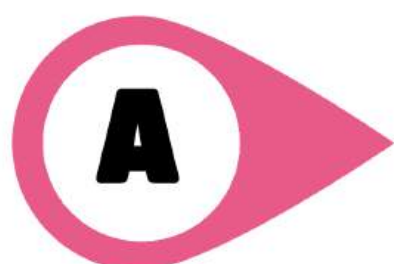
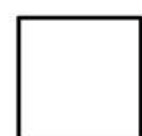
For your safety, please avoid standing or moving around the bus while it is in motion. Kindly remain seated until the bus has come to a complete stop!

Important Please Read

Canadian

Citizens 16 and older require a valid passport.
Citizens 15 years and younger require a valid passport or can present their birth certificate. All minors under the age of 18 require a signed minor consent form if both parents are not traveling with them.



Non-Canadian

Non-Canadian Citizens will be required to apply for a Pre-Travel Authorization 72 hours prior to departure by applying at <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta>.

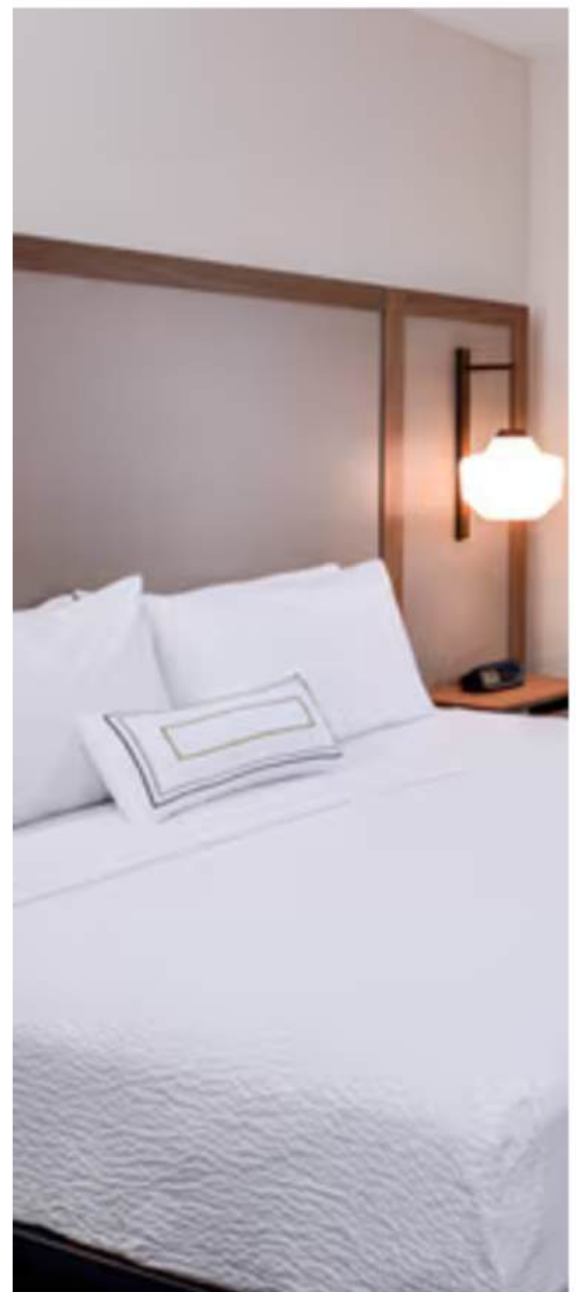

Terms and Conditions

- 1.No Exchanges or Refunds:** A complete list of terms and conditions is available online at www.ontourconcerts.ca.
- 2.Discretion of On Tour Concerts Inc:** On Tour Concerts Inc (hereafter referred to as “OTC”) will make every effort to conduct the charter trip but does not guarantee that the coach will arrive or depart from any location at a specific time. OTC is not liable for any loss, costs—including temporary accommodations—or damage to any individual or property resulting from any cause, including OTC's own negligence, as well as any changes, delays, or cancellations of a charter trip due to factors such as poor road or weather conditions, an ordered closure of Confederation Bridge, acts of God, public enemies, legal authorities, mechanical failures, quarantines, navigational hazards, riots, strikes, war-related incidents, accidents, or any conditions beyond OTC's control.
- 3.Missed Bus Policy:** If you miss the bus, it is your responsibility to arrange alternative transportation to and from the charter destination, and you will bear any costs incurred.
- 4.Coach Operation Safety:** It is solely at OTC's discretion to determine whether it is safe or advisable to operate the coach under any conditions. All indicated itinerary times are approximate and subject to change without prior notice.
